Deep well injection (DWI) is typically used for fluids that we don't want, such as municipal waste water, excessive storm water, reverse osmosis brines, landfill leachate, hydraulic fracturing fluids and fluids from industrial process. DWI can also be used to store CO_2 , enhance oil production, prevent saline intrusion, and facilitate solution mining. The drivers for adopting the technology for disposal are principally the economic cost of treatment and may be triggered by environmental regulations such as limitations on ocean disposal or on the need to reduce stormwater flood peaks. The principal concerns of objectors to DWI are the potential threats to groundwater.

The Miami program will provide a national update on the current status of deep well injection disposal of fluids. The program is aimed at current industrial and municipal users of the technology and at potential adopters of fluid injection strategies. The presentations will include discussion of local, state and federal disposal policies that are the drivers for DWI installations. Speakers will describe the latest science & technology in design, construction, operation, maintenance, modeling and monitoring of deep well injection. There will be case studies from DWI operations the US and overseas. The two-day program will provide a focused information exchange and discussion opportunity among presenters and participants.
