There are **2 options** for transport logistics.

- **1.** Bus will pick up tour participants at the conference hotel at 7:15am on Sunday 11th (Meet in the lobby of the Gateway Hotel, 2200 East Holt Boulevard, Ontario, California 91761) and return to the hotel in the bus after the tour (approximately 5:30pm). **Or.**
- **2** Meet the bus at Twentynine Palms at 9:30am (Meet outside the Twentynine Palms City Hall at 6136 Adobe Rd., Twentynine Palms, CA 92277) and return to Twentynine Palms after the tour (approximately 3:30pm).
- Option 2 participants must make their own travel arrangements to and from Twentynine Palms.
- There will be transport for the field trip departing Twentynine Palms at 9:30am.
- The expected time of return to Twentynine Palms is 3:30pm.
- Coffee, snacks and a barbecue lunch will be provided.
- The field trip will include a presentation by chief hydrologist Terry Foreman.
- There is no charge to attend this field trip. Limited space. First come-first served.

The field trip will include a presentation at the Cadiz Ranch Office outlining the physical characteristics of the hydrology and geology, the water conservation, supply, and storage project concept, the results of technical feasibility studies, and the proposed engineering and groundwater development required for project implementation. In addition to an overall perspective of the Cadiz Water Project, the tour will include a stop at the Bristol Dry Lake, a groundwater recharge demonstration spreading ground, and Cadiz sustainable and organic agriculture.
